Short Courses Australia offer 25 Vocational Education & Training (VET) short courses, suitable for delivery to secondary school students.

Students can be enrolled into short courses facilitated daily at our training centres in Melbourne and Port Melbourne. Or each short course can be scheduled for delivery at any secondary school within Melbourne and regional Victoria.

Nominal hours of each unit of competence can be accumulated and attributed towards the VCE VET Elective, Vocational Major (VM) or Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC).

Students can be enrolled into a packaged VETDSS Industry Taster Program, or a JOB CAMP program can be built, specific to the needs of your students.

- For VPC Students it meets the VET requirement of the new certificate.

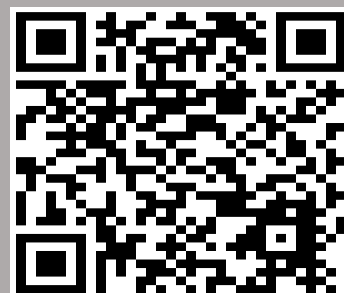
