Short Courses Australia provide a drive in and drive out training strategy that enables delivery of 25 Vocational Education & Training (VET) short courses, available to secondary school students by way of incursion, within Melbourne and regional Victoria.

Students can also be enrolled into short courses facilitated daily at our training centres at 350 Collins Street, Melbourne, and Port Melbourne.

Nominal hours of each unit of competence can be accumulated and attributed towards the VCE VET Elective, Vocational Major (VM) or Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC).

Students can now also enroll into our Summer Skills JOB CAMP programs, designed to support student transition this holiday season into paid employment.
