# VM 90 Hospitality

90 Nominal Hours (SCH) from the Hospitality training package, equals One Credit towards the Vocational Major (VM)

## HOSPITALITY SKILL SET

The VM 90 Hospitality introduces students to the hospitality industry and provides a set of skills and compliance certificates necessary for entry level employment within a Restaurant, Café, or Bar.

Day one comprises RSA and an introduction to each unit of competence. Day two to seven is dedicated to training and formulative assessment across food safety, coffee and non-alcoholic beverages, whereby students transition across a **Six Station Rotation** within a high energy simulated workplace environment. Day eight is dedicated to first aid practical training and assessment.

The VM 90 Hospitality is delivered at our college campus located at Level 1, 350 Collins Street, Melbourne or at your Secondary School, Victoria wide.

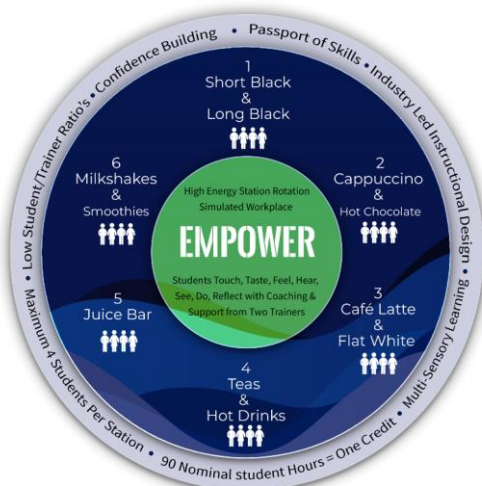

**JOB CAMP** provides year 9 to 12 students with a fun and interactive introduction to vocational training that supports transition into entry level paid casual, employment.

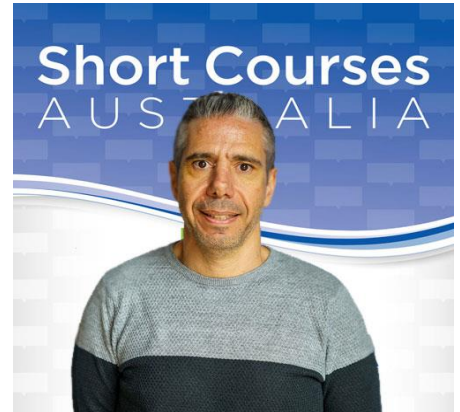
Students achieve essential foundation skills & compliance certificates necessary to remove barriers to gain employment.
